TERMS & CONDITIONS

- 1. The value of an impact is equal to USD 1 off your project fee
- 2. 50% of each impact can be redeemed as cash
- 3. Impacts can be donated to the African Impact Foundation
- 4. Impacts, or USD commission, can only be redeemed by a past African Impact volunteer or intern
- 5. Participants cannot collect both impacts and USD commission for the same task
- 6. Once redeemed, impacts will revert back to USD 0
- 7. Payment of commission will only be made once the Ambassador has collated USD 150 in commission (not impacts)
- 8. Redeeming impacts for a placement will be subject to availability and can only be applied to African Impact-owned projects. Projects where the discount does not apply are:
